2. Coach's Report Coach Tritton

- a. Update on Head Coach position
 - Coach Wells will be the new head coach for the 2024-2025 Season. Coach Tritton will still be head coach until the end of the school year.
 - Kelli Goffredi will become the JV coach.
 - New Freshmen Coach Coach Krueger will be our new freshman coach for the 2024-2025 season. She currently teaches English at the 9th grade campus.

b. UIL tryouts

• The white gym is closed until Friday, so tryouts will be postponed until Monday 5/13. Nationals competition will be Jan 24-26 (traditional). UiL is Jan 11th (game day). Traditional routines are similar to all-star (pyramids, running tumbling, etc.). Game Day is band chant and side-line situationals and crowd-leading cheers. Small intermediate teams is what we are aiming for. One practice will be held per week for each that won't go past 4:45pm. Spirit days have been decided.

3. Treasurer's Report

b. Budget

- Draft budget for the new season is being reviewed by the board and will be put to a vote at next board meeting in September. This year we will not be going to Disney, but will be attending NCA.
- Current revenue will come from the sponsorship drive and the Junior Jag Camps.
 Sponsorship revenue is key otherwise we will be required to cut back on the program.

c. Transition with previous Treasurer

- The 3 years of unfiled taxes were assessed penalties totaling over \$7k. All three years were appealed with the help of or CPA firm, Peter Marshall & Co. The oldest year (COVID year) with the largest penalty of \$4K was removed

d. Financials

- March closed with a profit of \$20K primarily due to the first cheer payments for this year being paid on March 22nd.
- April closed with a deficit of \$7,768 with large payments going out for new uniforms and the Great Wolf Lodge Camp charges.
